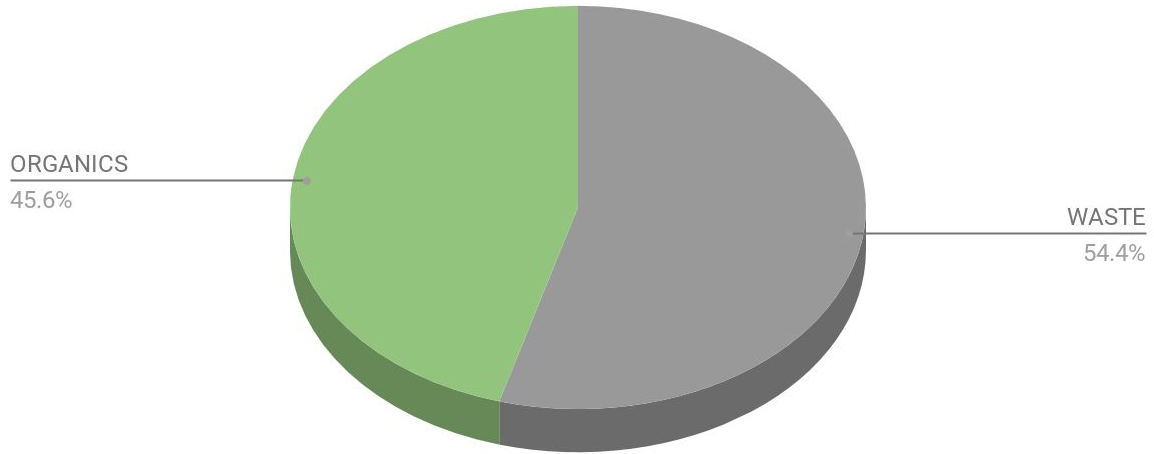
The numbers speak for themselves so we don't have much else to add.

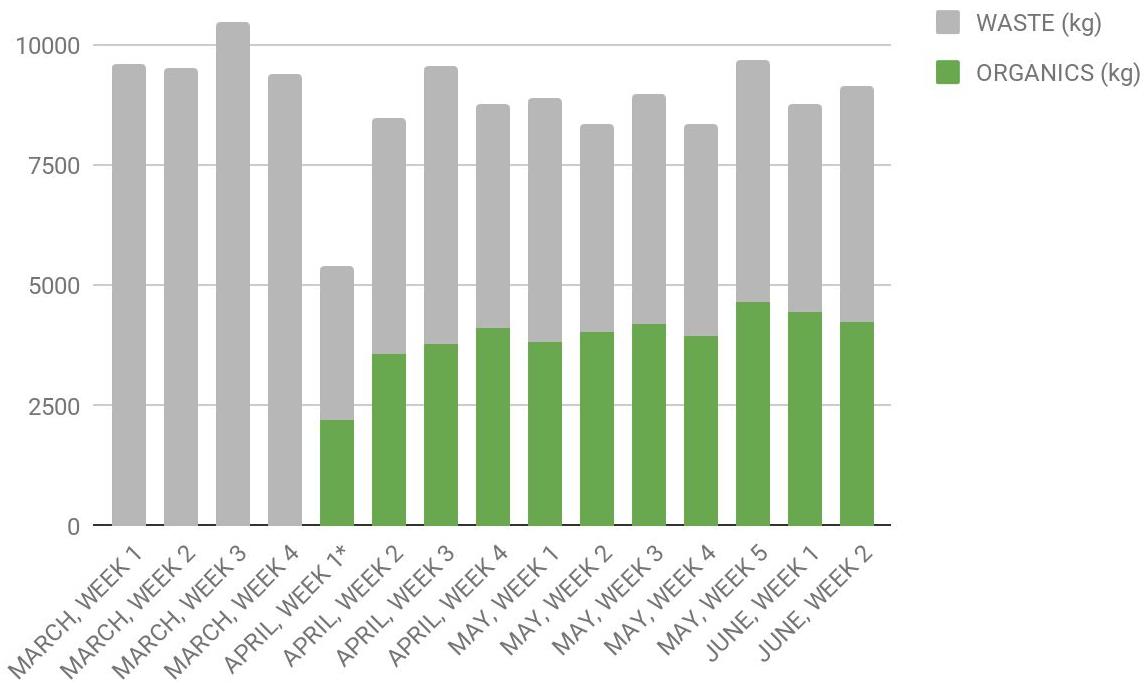
