

PLANNED CAPITAL PROJECTS: 2019



GENERAL PROJECTS



Gibsons Way Improvements Phase I - multi-use pathway on the west side of the downslope into Lower Gibsons.

Gibsons Way improvements (Phase II) - \$472,000

To cover construction costs of a 1.5km downhill bike lane on the south side of Gibsons Way, from School Road to North Fletcher. It is intended that cyclists would then use North Fletcher and cross at School Road.

Pavement rehabilitation - \$363,000

To rehabilitate deteriorating pavement (exact roadways to be determined.) Typically, at least \$300,000 is allocated for pavement rehabilitation each year.

494 South Fletcher interior improvements - \$189,000

To facilitate the creation of office spaces for rent at the building previously occupied by Vancouver Coastal Health.

Whitetower Pond upgrade (Phase I) - \$143,000

To improve flow control to the existing ponds, which provide integral stormwater management services to Upper Gibsons. The work will create minimal disturbance to Whitetower Park.



Natural assets, such as these ponds in Whitetower Park, provide Gibsons with vital civil services at less cost than engineered assets.

Vehicle & Equipment replacement (Dump Truck) - \$100,000

To replace dump truck, which is one of the key vehicles for Public Works. The Town has a reserve fund for the regular replacement of vehicles and equipment.

Franklin & Pebbles Beach restoration - \$60,000

To repair storm damage sustained in December 2018.
