
PLANNED CAPITAL PROJECTS: 2019 SANITARY PROJECTS





Wastewater Treatment Plant Optimization + Upgrades - \$2.1 million

The current wastewater treatment plant was commissioned in 2005. Upgrades are now required, so that the Town may continue to meet our Provincial permitting requirements to discharge treated effluent to the ocean. Upgrades will also ensure the plant continues to run as efficiently as possible. This project is partially funded by grant monies.

The WWTP is a complex system which requires highly trained personnel to operate and manage it.

Prowse Road Lift Station design + construction - \$1.8 million

To upgrade the Prowse Road Lift Station, which provides service for the roughly 30% of the Town's sanitary flows that cannot drain by gravity directly to the treatment plant. This project will be financed by debt.

Armours Beach and Coles Trunk Sewer Scour Protection - \$488,000

To construct foreshore protection in front of Armours Beach and the old

Coles Marina site. The improvements in front of Armours will comprise the replacement of the failing block wall with sloped rock protection. Improvements in front of Coles are intended to



build up an area over the trunk sewer to provide a continuous level area for maintenance vehicles and pedestrians.

Currently, the seawalk that runs from Armours Beach to the Gibsons Public Market is interrupted at the old Coles Marina site.
