The Town of Gibsons has an opening for a Casual Parks Labourer I.

The Parks Labourer reports to the Manager of Maintenance and Operations and is responsible for: the maintenance and upgrading of public spaces; the operation and maintenance of small tools and equipment; performing a variety of tasks in all types of weather; tidiness and cleanliness of public spaces.

This union position requires a person in good physical condition, able to work unsupervised from time to time and available to work weekends.

REQUIRED EDUCATION/TRAINING:

1. Completion of Grade 12 education or equivalent
2. Valid BC Class 5 Driver's License
3. Experience in the maintenance and construction of municipal parks and horticultural practices.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Completion of appropriate entry level horticulture training program (e.g. one-year Horticultural Technician Program).
2. Ability to identify various species of trees, shrubs, flowers, invasive species, etc.
3. Must be able to deal courteously with the public.
4. Must be able to work within a team to achieve improvements in Town operations.
5. Must be physically capable of carrying out assigned duties, such as performing heavy outdoor manual work year-round in all types of weather.
6. Must be able to take and carry out direction.

The rate of pay is currently \$26.40 per hour in accordance with the BCGEU Collective Agreement.
