THE APPLICANT CERTIFIES that they understand and will strictly abide by all the provisions set forth in the Town's Fireworks Bylaw No. 1034 and all provincial and federal laws and regulations in force from time to time and any conditions or restrictions imposed in this permit by the Fire Chief.

THE APPLICANT UNDERSTANDS that they are responsible for the care, storage, transportation and discharge of the fireworks they have in their possession. They are also responsible for maintaining adequate insurance as set forth in the Town's Bylaw. Upon the failure to discharge any fireworks on the specified date, it is the responsibility of the owner of the fireworks to make arrangements with the Fire Chief to safely dispose of them. The application fee for this Permit is non-refundable and the Permit is liable to rescission without financial reimbursement should any information supplied in this application be found to be false or should the applicant contravene any of the provisions set forth in the Town's Fireworks Bylaw No. 1034 or any provincial and federal laws or regulations.

THE APPLICANT COVENANTS that the Applicant will indemnify and save harmless the Town and its elected officials, employees, officers, agents and contractors from and against any and all manner of actions or causes of action, damages, cost, loss, or expenses of whatever kind (including, without limitation, legal fees) which the Town or its elected officials, employees, officers, agents and contractors may sustain, incur, or be put to by reason of or arising out of:

1. the issuance of this permit;
2. the sale, display for sale, offering for sale or any otherwise dispose of fireworks to any person by the Applicant; or
3. any act or omission of the Applicant or any person for whom the Applicant at law, responsible, including, without limitation, the non-observance or non-performance of any obligation imposed by federal or provincial law.
