Interested persons can obtain information on the requirements and procedures for making nominations including nomination forms at the Town of Gibsons, 474 South Fletcher Road, Gibsons, BC beginning 9:00 am Tuesday, August 2, 2022 until the close of the nomination period.

### QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- age 18 or older on general voting day October 15, 2022; and
- a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

### CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 general local election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

MAYOR	\$ 10,797.83
COUNCILLOR	\$ 5,398.92

### THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING LIMITS
