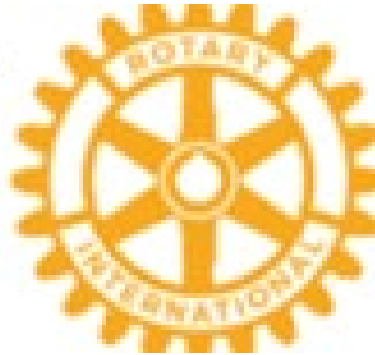

# Armours Beach Improvement Project

- In 2018 Gibsons Rotary in collaboration with the Town of Gibsons and Longman Developments Ltd. completed Phase 1 of the Armours Beach Shoreline Improvement Project including washroom facilities, an accessible pathway, landscaping and picnic tables.
- Now Gibsons Rotary wants to build Phase 2 of the Armours Beach Improvement Project with a focus on marine park improvements.

Armours Beach is full of activity above, on and below the waters of Howe Sound. The view between this shore and Kuper Island creates depths of blue, green and is home to many mammals, sea creatures, birds and fish. Located in the traditional territory of Squamish First Nation (Skwaxwiyechwiyem Unceded) Armours Beach is part of the Town of Gibsons.

- Sheltered beach area raked of rocks / imported sand



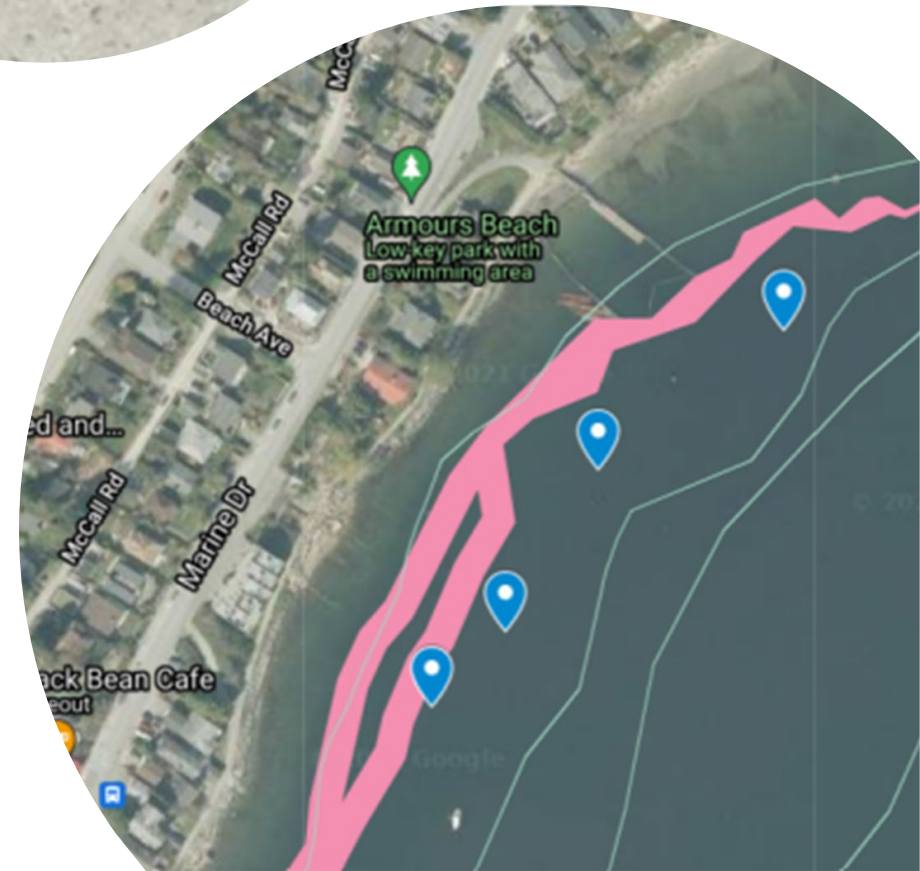


## Community Benefits

- Sheltered safe space for moms & tots to swim
- Active outdoor summertime space for teens
- Easy marine access for adults and seniors to swim, launch paddle boards, kayaks, etc.

# Environmentally Sensitive Design

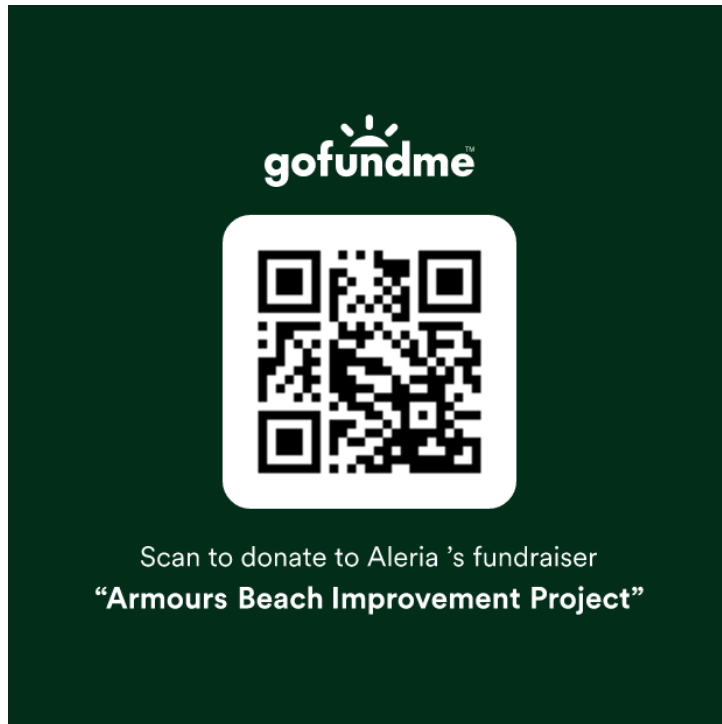
- No marine micro plastics due to high-density polyethylene (HDPE) pontoon construction (No Styrofoam!)
- Minimal eelgrass shading due to single dock design and no moorage
- No erosion or benthic impacts due to suspended “Eco-Mooring Lines” where concrete blocks are needed

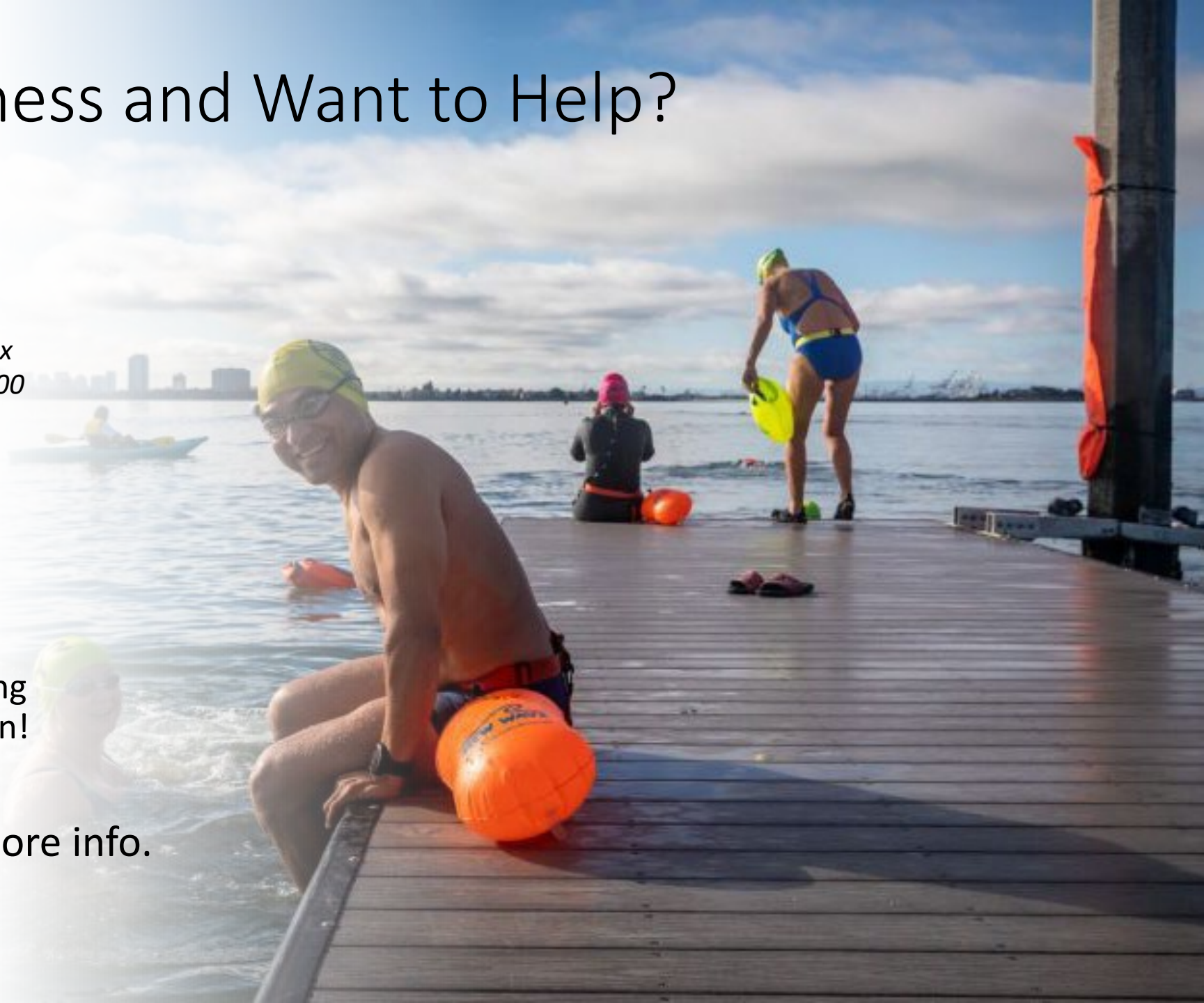
