Interested persons can obtain information on the requirements and procedures for making nominations including nomination forms will be available at the Town of Gibsons, 474 South Fletcher Road, Gibsons, BC beginning 9:00 am Tuesday, August 4, 2026, until the close of the nomination period.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day October 17, 2026;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, the following expense limits, inclusive of taxes, apply to candidates during the campaign period for the 2026 general local election:

MAYOR \$12,323.78
COUNCILLOR \$6,161.89

THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2026 general local elections, the following third-party advertising limits apply:
